**\*PWHM will be awarding a \$100 prize for the horse (excludes Mountain Horses) that has the most points at the end of the show. NEMHC will be awarding a total of \$100 in increments of \$40, \$30, \$20, & \$10 for the top 4, high-point Mountain Horses of the day.**

**-Open and All Day Pleasure classes are open to any gaited breed, unless the class says MH. MH classes are for Mountain Horses only.**

**-Cross entries allowed. Unless otherwise stated, all classes open to amateurs or professionals. Shoe sizes follow NWHA rules.**

**-Novice Classes** –Open to any gaited breed. The Novice horse, or the Novice rider, cannot have won 3 blue ribbons in prior season

**-Schooling Classes** – At the end of the class the Judge may give you tips on how to improve either your horse or your riding. If you have questions, please wait until after the show to ask the judge as time will be limited in the class.

**-All Day Pleasure, Country Pleasure, and Versatility riders may MAY use 2 hands if riding western.** All other Western classes must use one hand, unless horse is under 4 yrs old and D ring snaffle is used.

**-Helmets required for 17 and under. Youths need permission slip, and concussion forms, signed by parent or guardian.**

-Classes indicated with a “V” qualify for the PWHMD versatility high point award – see show book for more info.

**-Championship classes** – Horse & rider must have exhibited in the indicated qualifying class in order to enter.

**PERSONS ON FEDERAL DISQUALIFICATION CANNOT TRANSPORT HORSES TO THIS SHOW AND CAN ONLY PARTICIPATE AS A SPECTATOR**
